

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The health and safety of our children is always our highest priority. To mitigate the risks of COVID-19 while your children are in our care, we are following the health and safety guidance of the Oregon Department of Education, Early Learning Division; the CDC guidelines; and guidance from the American Academy of Pediatrics.

FACIAL COVERINGS

All staff members and adults dropping off and picking up children will wear facemasks. In addition, all Kindergarteners will wear facemasks during class. Facemasks are optional for 3's and Pre-K children




HEALTH CHECKS

Children and staff will be screened daily upon arrival for signs of illness. Children or staff who have signs of illness will not be allowed to enter the classroom. Parents will need to certify that their child is fever free, does not have an unusual cough, has no loss of taste or smell, no shortness of breath, or has not been exposed to a case of COVID-19. If a child becomes ill during class, they will be separated from other children and parent will need to pick him/her up.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

Children will be assigned to a stable group (pod) of classmates with the same assigned teachers. Children will not interact with other classes during the day, including on the playground. Teachers will socially distance with parents/children who are not part of their pod. In their class pod, staff and children are not required to physically distance. All parents must socially distance with all other people on campus, except their child.



SANITATION

We continue our focus on handwashing and disinfecting throughout the day. After class, all toys and surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected. A professional cleaning service will clean at night, including floors, tables, high-touch points, and bathrooms.



SNACKS

Children will bring their own healthy snacks throughout the year. Snacks are not shared, and hands will be washed before and after snack time. Water is our drink of choice.
